Thank you for reminding us that there are still people who care about others."

Que significado e que lugar ocupam na nossa vida os projetos de Deus? Esforçamo-nos, como Jesus, por descobrir a vontade de Deus a nosso respeito e a respeito do mundo? Mantemo-nos atentos, em cada passo do nosso caminho, a esses “sinais dos tempos” através dos quais Deus nos interpela? Somos capazes de acolher e de viver com fidelidade e radicalidade as propostas de Deus, mesmo quando elas são exigentes e vão contra os nossos interesses e projetos pessoais?
