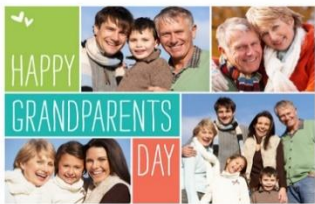


Rosarians, who are available, can:
