*1 CORINTHIANS 3:16*

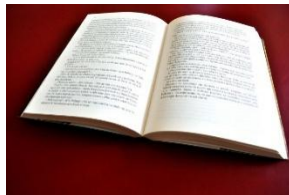

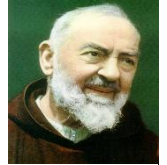
